The CPT Certification addresses the core technical competencies of higher skilled production workers in all sectors of manufacturing, including automotive manufacturing and related suppliers. MSSC awards certificates to individuals who pass any of its Production Modules: Safety, Quality Practices & Measurement, Manufacturing Processes & Production, and Maintenance Awareness; and a full Certified Production Technician (CPT) Certification to those who pass all four original modules.
