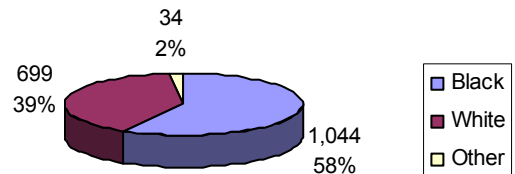

Total Enrollment by Gender

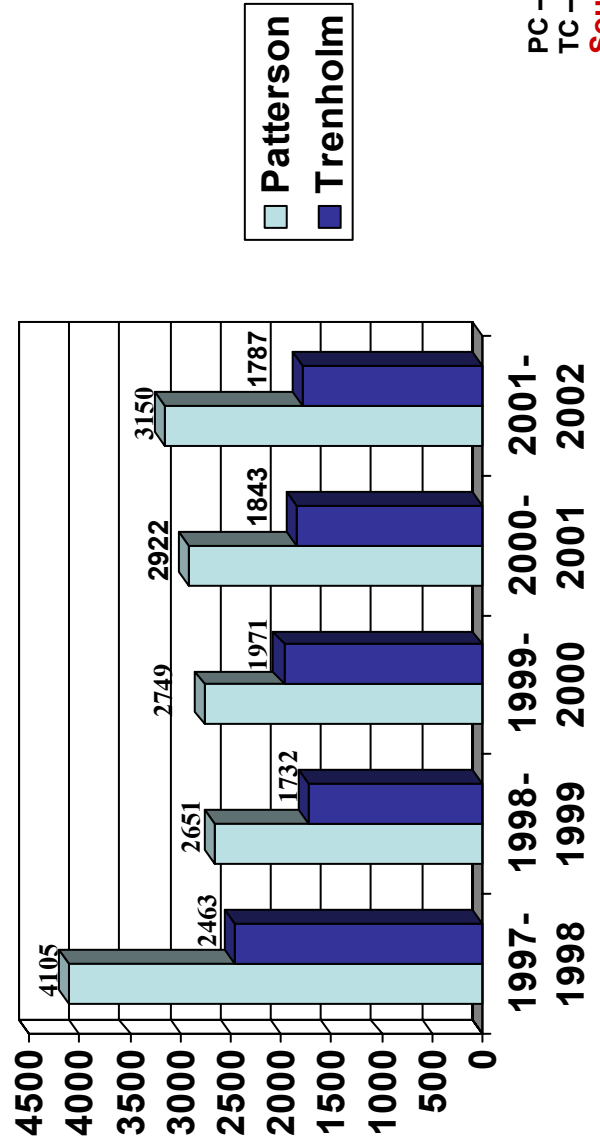


Total Enrollment by Race
