Institutional scholarships are awarded to high school graduates, GED recipients and first-time Trenholm State students.

In order to be eligible for consideration, students **MUST**:

- **Have satisfied all Admissions requirements at the College**
- **Complete a scholarship application**
- **Include high school transcript, GED Certificate, college transcript(s) (if applicable) with a 2.5 Cumulative Grade-Point Average (CGPA) on a 4.0 grading scale**
- **Provide three (3) signed letters of recommendation on official letterhead from the high school principal, counselor and a teacher. Letters from family members or friends will not be accepted. If you are applying for the Institutional scholarship NOT within the same year of high school graduation, you must provide three (3) signed professional letters of recommendation on official letterhead. Letters from family members or friends will not be accepted.**
- **Explain in a 500 word typed essay your career goals and why you should be considered for a scholarship.**

Career Technical scholarships are available to high school students through a recommendation from the director of a career technical center. The director will have the authority to approve one scholarship on an annual basis during the months of April and May.

In order to be eligible for consideration, students **MUST**:

- **Have satisfied all Admissions requirements at the College**
- **Complete a scholarship application**
- **Include high school transcript with a 2.5 Cumulative Grade-Point Average (CGPA) on a 4.0 grading scale**
- **Provide three (3) signed letters of recommendation on official letterhead from the high school principal or director of the local technical center; a counselor, a teacher and/or an employer. Letters from family members or friends will not be accepted.**
- **Explain in a 500 word typed essay your career goals and why you should be considered for a scholarship.**

New Scholarships are awarded to new and currently enrolled students with a 2.0 Cumulative Grade-Point Average (CGPA) on a 4.0 grading scale and who are interested in Music at TSCC.

In order to be eligible for consideration, students **MUST**:

- **Have satisfied all Admissions requirements at the College**
- **Complete the Scholarship Application with the exception of the Essay**
- **Provide three (3) signed letters of recommendation on official letterhead from the high school principal, counselor and music teacher. If you are applying for the Fine Arts scholarship NOT within the same year of high school graduation, you must provide three (3) signed professional letters of recommendation on official letterhead. Letters from family members or friends will not be accepted.**
- **Audition with the Music Faculty. To schedule an audition, please contact Lewis Webb at (334) 420-4327 or at: lwebb@trenholmstate.edu. For the 2018 fall semester, auditions should be scheduled by June 30.**
- **Be prepared to sing two vocal solos in contrasting styles**
- **Bring a copy of your current Resumé to the audition**

*A Music Theory Placement Test is required for applicants who pass the Audition phase.

Achievement scholarships are awarded to currently enrolled and returning students at the College who have earned a minimum of 12 full-time credit hours with a minimum 3.50 Cumulative Grade-Point Average (CGPA).

In order to be eligible for consideration, students **MUST**:

- **Have satisfied all Admissions requirements at the College**
- **Complete a scholarship application**
- **Provide three (3) signed letters of recommendation on official letterhead from a Trenholm State employee. Letters from family members or friends will not be accepted.**
- **Include current Trenholm State transcript**
- **Include a Resumé**
- **Explain in a 500 word typed essay your career goals and why you should be considered for a scholarship.**

POLICY

The Policy of the College regarding scholarship awards is to assure that the most comprehensive procedures are in place to recognize prospective students, currently enrolled and returning students who desire to start or continue in a career technical program of instruction.

The type of scholarships awarded include Institutional, Achievement and Career Technical. Students may only apply for one (1) scholarship type.

These scholarships consist of a waiver of tuition and fees on a term-by-term basis, upon availability, for one (1) program only. Books, insurance, graduation fees and supplies are NOT covered by these scholarships.

Students applying for any type of scholarship MUST complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA).

The scholarship will be awarded for the term of the student's intended enrollment and will be forfeited if not used for the designated period. The scholarship will consist of a waiver of tuition and fees on a term- by-term basis, upon availability, for one (1) program of study only. To remain on a scholarship, recipients must remain continuously and consecutively enrolled, maintain the required cumulative grade-point average, meet attendance requirements and not violate any College policies.
