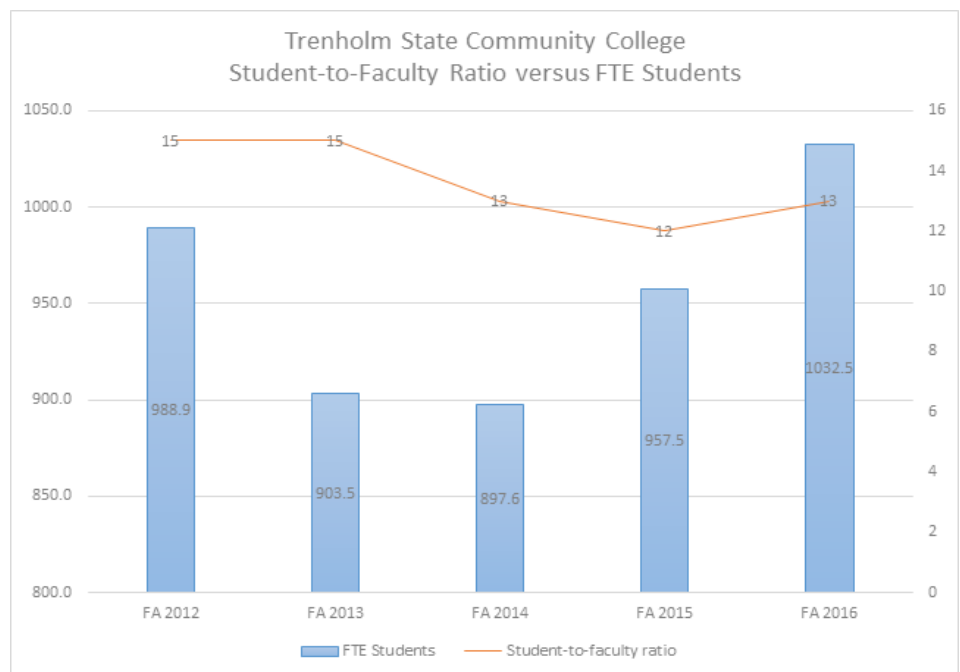

Student to Faculty Ratio at Trenholm State

INSTITUTIONAL RESEARCHERS:
Bridging the Gap Between Data and Decisions

The student to faculty ratio measures the overall size of the college's instructional faculty versus the overall size of the student body. According to IPEDS, the full-time (FTE) of faculty is calculated by summing the total number of full-time staff and adding one-third of the total number of part-time faculty. The full-time equivalent (FTE) of students is a single value providing a meaningful combination of full-time and part-time students. A lower student-to-faculty ratio is better for students. At Trenholm State we have a student-to-faculty ratio of 13:1 for fall 2016.
