

COVID-19 Institutional Protocols

(12/8/22)

Trenholm State Community College is committed to maintaining a healthy and safe environment for all students, employees, and visitors while on campus or instructional sites. The College continues to monitor the COVID-19 virus and safety of all. The following protocols for COVID-19 should be followed by all students, employees, and visitors until further notice.

- 1. Students, employees, and visitors may wear face coverings at their discretion.
- 2. For any person arriving on campus with signs or symptoms of COVID-19 or any person with a confirmed case of COVID-19 desiring to return to campus, the College will continue to follow applicable guidance.

COVID-19 Positive Results

In accordance with Trenholm State Community College, please follow the provided guidelines for positive test results and COVID-19 exposure.

Persons with Positive COVID-19 Test Results

Everyone, regardless of vaccination status, shall:

- Stay home for 5 days and isolate from others
- If there are no symptoms or symptoms are resolving after 5 days, individual may return to campus/work
- Individual shall wear a mask around others for 5 additional days

Note: If the individual has a fever, they should continue to stay home until the fever resolves

COVID-19 Exposure

Individuals who are fully vaccinated within the last 6 months OR have been boosted:

- Do not have to quarantine
- Wear a mask around others for 10 days

Individuals who are fully vaccinated over 6 months and not boosted or are unvaccinated shall:

• Stay home for 5 days. After that, continue to wear a mask around others for 5 additional days.

NOTIFICATIONS

Students

- Students should notify Jennifer Lewis, Coronavirus Response Specialist of a positive COVID-19 lab confirmed test and/or positive COV ID-19 home test.at_ilewis@trenholmstate.edu or 334-523-7474.
- Students should also notify instructor(s) of a positive COVID-19 lab confirmed test and/or COVID-19 home test.
- Instructors who are made aware of a student's positive diagnosis in their area or classroom must immediately contact Louis Campbell, Director of Facilities at 334-799-6567 for disinfecting assistance
- All students testing positive for COVID-19 must obtain clearance from the Coronavirus Response Specialist before returning to campus or any clinical setting.

Employees

- Employees should notify Jennifer Lewis, Coronavirus Response Specialist of a positive COVID-19 lab confirmed test and/or a COVID-19 home test at jlewis@trenholmstate.edu or 334-523-7474.
- Employees should also notify their immediate supervisor of a positive COVID-19 lab confirmed and/or positive COVID-19 home test.
- Supervisors who are made aware of an individual's positive diagnosis in their area must immediately contact Louis Campbell, Director of Facilities at 334-799-6567 for disinfecting assistance.
- All employees testing positive for COVID-19 must obtain clearance from the Coronavirus Response Specialist before returning to campus

All students and employees should email a copy of the positive test results upon notifying the Coronavirus Response Specialist. All pertinent information will be communicated via email including but not limited to:

- Quarantine days
- Quarantine end date

- COVID-19 questionnaire
- Tentative return date pending clearance from the Coronavirus Response Specialist
