



Course Placement Guidelines

The Course Placement Guidelines provide three options to determine appropriate placement in Math and English classes. *Scores may be used for placement up to five years from the date of test. Math grade and GPA may be used for placement up to five years from the high school graduation date. Math grade must be from Algebra II, Elements of College Math, Algebra II with Trigonometry, Pre-Calculus, or Calculus.

Screening Level 1: ACT OR SAT Scores

Screening Level 2: High school GPA and Algebra II grade

Screening Level 3: Accuplacer Placement.

MATH Exemption Guidelines: Any student scoring at or above the established ACT or SAT score for MATH within five years of enrollment is exempt from the subject specific placement assessment and is eligible for courses based on high school math completed.

GED – Students who score ≥ 165 on the Mathematical Reasoning subject tests of the 2014 series are eligible for Math 100, Math 110, Math 112, and above.

ENGLISH Exemption Guidelines Any student scoring at or above the established ACT score for either English/Writing or Reading within five years of enrollment is exempt from the subject specific placement assessment and is eligible for English 101.

GED – Students who score ≥ 165 on the Reasoning Through Language Arts subject tests of the 2014 series GED are eligible for English 101

ENGLISH 101 and ENGLISH 102 Course Credit

Students who have an ACT score of 30-34 in English are exempt from English 101. Students who have an official ACT score in English of 35-36 will receive credit for English 101 and 102. ACT scores may not be more than five years old.
