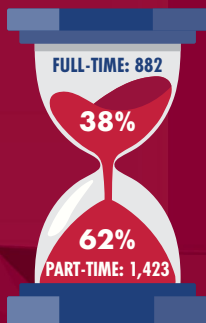

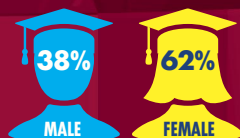
# FALL 2025 TOTAL ENROLLMENT - 2,305

## CREDIT STATUS

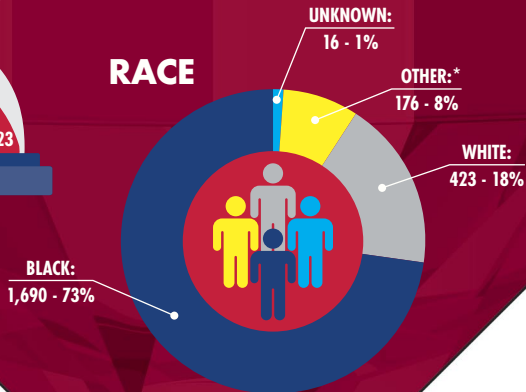

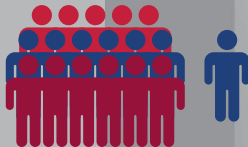
